Attendance certificates will be available following the meeting.

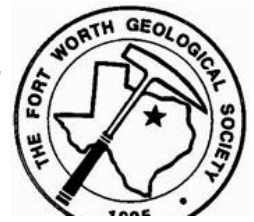

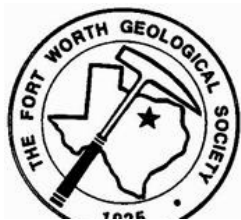
